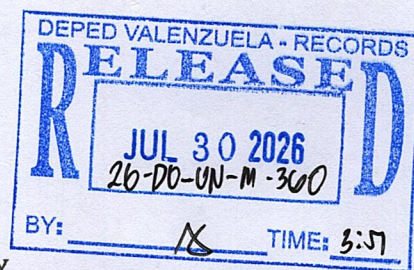

In this regard, is requested to strictly observe the following guidelines:

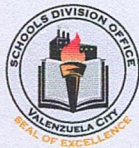

2. Strict observance of the Data Privacy Act of 2012 to ensure the confidentiality and protection of learners' personal information;
3. Compliance with DepEd Order No.19, s. 2008, "No Collection Policy in Public Schools";
4. Compliance with DepEd Order No. 105, s. 2010, "Reiterating the Constitutional Right of DepEd Personnel and Students to Free Exercise of Religion";
5. Compliance with DepEd Order 49, s. 2009, "Reiterating the Revised Rules and Regulations on the Teaching of Religion in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools";
6. Proper coordination with the concerned school before the conduct of the activity;
7. Securing written parental consent for the voluntary participation of learners in the activity; and
8. For your reference and coordination, the attached school directory may be used.

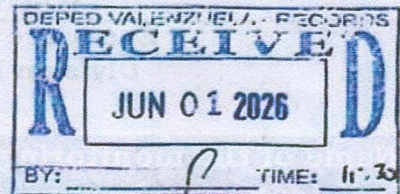

- Donation of Bibles and other learning materials, when available, to school libraries to support student learning and engagement, particularly during PVEP sessions.

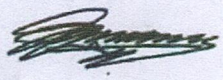
