1. For the information and guidance of all concerned, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division announces the conduct of District Science and Technology Fair 2026 for both Elementary and Secondary levels on September 4, 2026.
2. The activity shall be conducted simultaneously in the designated district venues as indicated below:

3. The activity aims to:
 - a. Provide opportunities for learners to showcase creativity, research skills, and innovative solutions to real-life-problems.
 - b. Encourage teamwork among students, teachers while improving learners' skills in presenting, defending their research output, and
 - c. Ensure quality outputs that are ready for division, regional, and national science and technology fairs by upholding standard of excellence in research.

3. The participation of elementary, junior and senior high school students in the said activity shall be clustered into different events:

Secondary	• Life Science Investigatory Project, (individual and team) • Physical Science Investigatory Project (individual and team) • Robotics Intelligent Machine (individual and team), • Science Innovation Expo (STEMIE) (individual and team), • SciQuiz.

4. The official participants for the Division Level shall be the Rank 1 and Rank 2 district winners in each category for both the elementary and secondary levels, duly endorsed by the respective District Chairperson. For the secondary level, the Science Department Heads/Coordinators shall be responsible for overseeing and managing the conduct of the activity.

5. The online submission of manuscripts for the Science Investigatory Project (STEMIE), Innovation Expo, and Robotics Intelligent Machine categories for the secondary level shall be open from 8:00 a.m. on August 10, 2026, until 12:01 p.m. on August 20, 2026. Upon the close of the submission period, the District Scientific Research Committee (SRC) shall verify the accuracy, completeness, and reliability of the submitted manuscripts.

6. Attached are the lists of the members of the Program Management Team and the Scientific Review Committee for reference. Likewise, Principal Consultants are invited to attend the said activity.

7. Expenses relative to the activity shall be charged to school canteen funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
