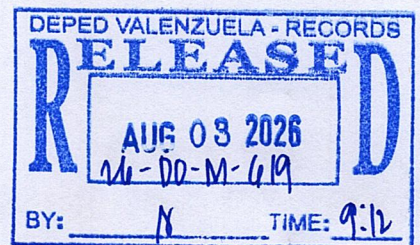

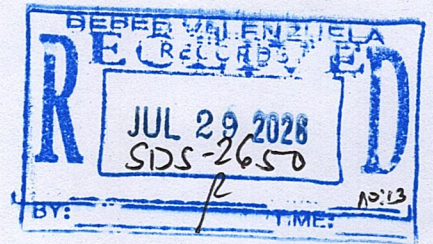

As part of the annual strengthening of the Red Cross Youth Program, we also encourage all schools to **renew and submit their RCY Accreditation** to the Philippine Red Cross – Valenzuela City Chapter. The reorganization of RCY Councils provides an opportunity for schools to elect or appoint qualified student leaders and faculty advisers who will spearhead Red Cross Youth activities aligned with the objectives of both the Department of Education and the Philippine Red Cross.

In this regard, we respectfully request your office to issue a memorandum informing all school heads to:

1. Conduct the reorganization of their respective Red Cross Youth Councils for School Year 2026–2027.
2. Designate or confirm the school's RCY Adviser.
3. Submit the accomplished RCY Accreditation requirements to the Philippine Red Cross – Valenzuela City Chapter on or before the prescribed deadline.

We believe that strengthening the Red Cross Youth Program will further empower learners to become compassionate, resilient, and socially responsible leaders in their schools and communities.

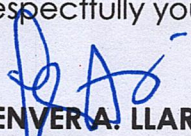
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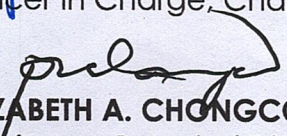
