This film focuses the emphasis on rescue and preparedness in dire times for before, on the time and after a disaster strike.





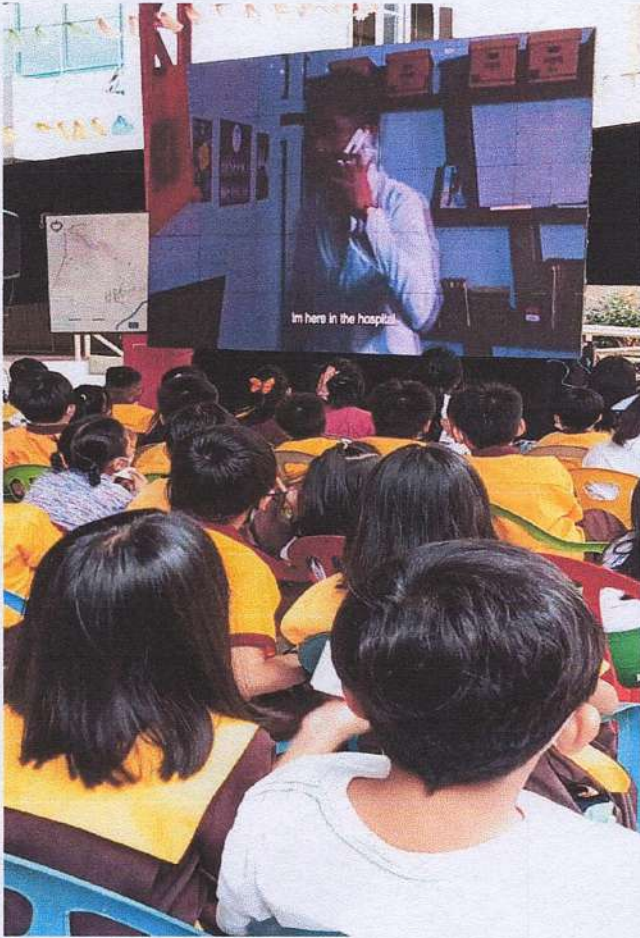


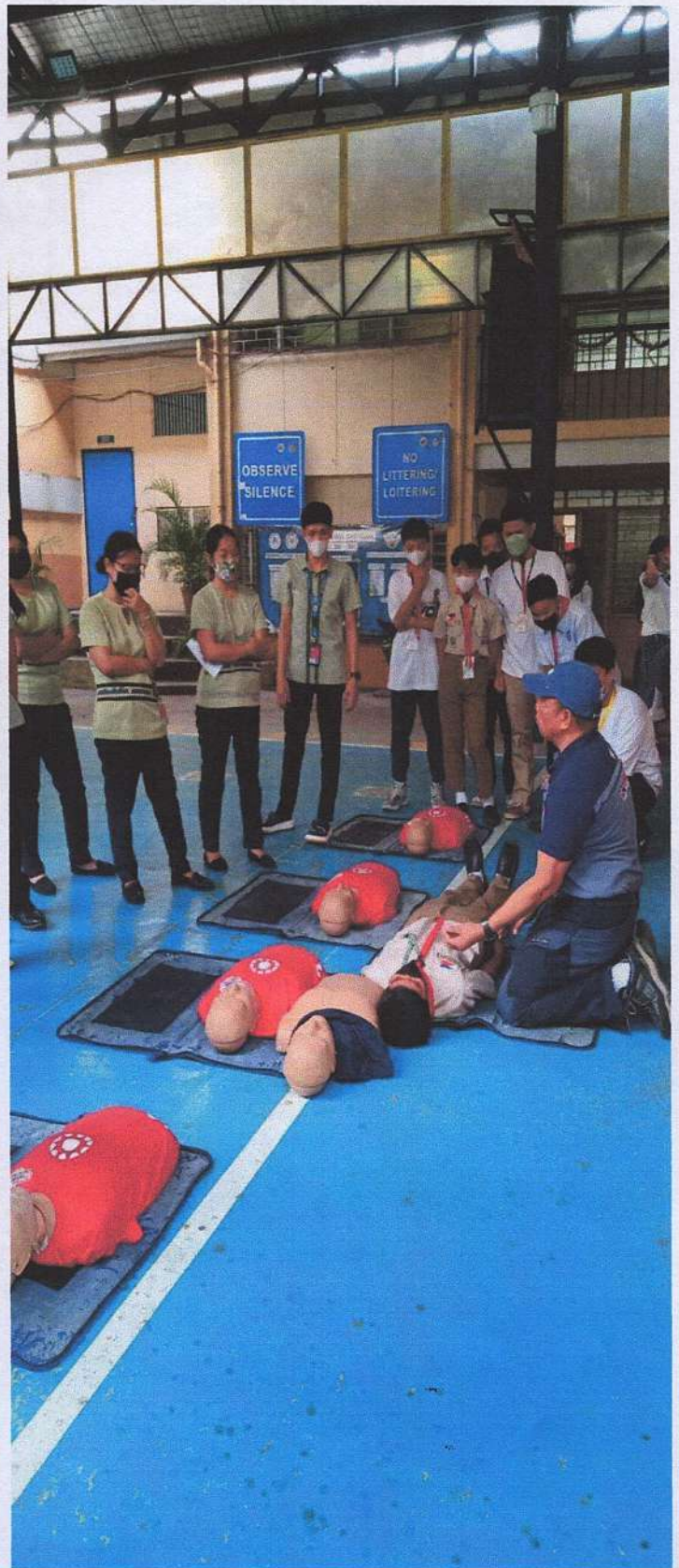
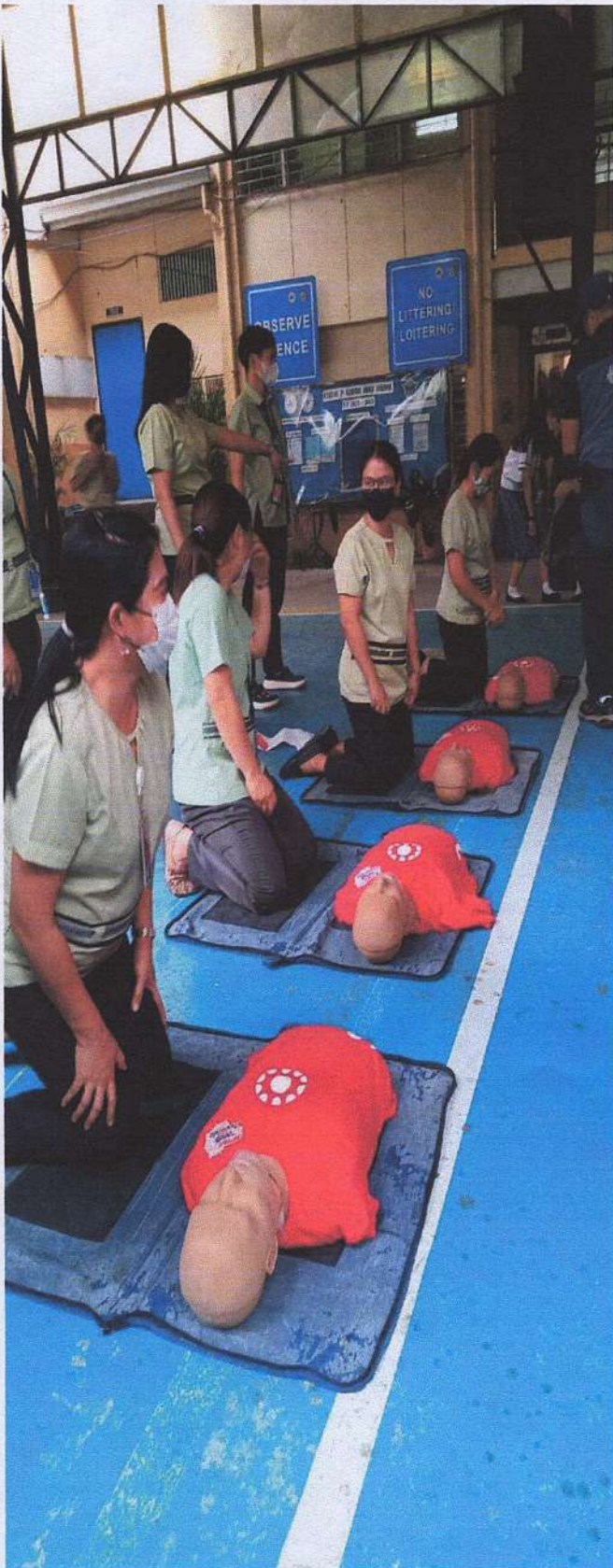
